

## NASTĘPNA STACJA... POLAND

KRAKÓW - WIELICZKA

**5 - 6 SEPTEMBER 2026**



Welcome to a two-day journey to Kraków and Wieliczka, home to some of Poland's most valuable cultural heritage sites, specially prepared for participants of the 21st World Congress of the International Union of Prehistoric and Protohistoric Sciences (UISPP). The programme includes visits to the Archaeological Museum in Kraków, the State Rooms at Wawel Royal Castle, and the Rynek Underground Museum, where visitors will explore the remains of the medieval city uncovered during archaeological excavations. On the second day, participants will visit the Wieliczka Salt Mine (UNESCO World Heritage Site), one of the world's oldest continuously operating salt mines. The excursion offers a unique opportunity to discover places of exceptional importance to archaeology, history and Poland's cultural heritage.

### **ITINERARY:**

#### **DAY 1: POZNAŃ - KRAKÓW: ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM - WAWEL - RYNEK UNDERGROUND MUSEUM**

Departure from Poznań at **4:30**. Transfer to Kraków. Visit to the Archaeological Museum in Kraków, where participants will explore outstanding collections illustrating the prehistory, antiquity and early history of Poland, as well as exceptional artefacts recovered during archaeological excavations conducted both in Poland and abroad. The programme continues with a guided tour of the State Rooms at Wawel Royal Castle, the historic residence of the Kings of Poland and one of the country's most important national symbols. Free time for lunch and coffee. Afterwards, participants will visit the Rynek Underground Museum, a modern archaeological reserve presenting the remains of medieval Kraków. The exhibition illustrates the history of the medieval city and presents the results of archaeological excavations carried out beneath the Main Market Square. Transfer to the hotel. Check-in. Dinner. Overnight stay.

#### **DAY 2: KRAKÓW - WIELICZKA - POZNAŃ**

Check out after breakfast. Transfer to the Wieliczka Salt Mine (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Guided tour of the Tourist Route. Participants will follow one of the world's most famous underground tourist routes, admiring chambers carved in salt, magnificent chapels, underground lakes and remarkable sculptures created by generations of miners. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Wieliczka Salt Mine has provided an exceptional testimony to the history of mining and technological development for more than 700 years. Group lunch. Departure for Poznań. Estimated arrival in Poznań at approximately **22:00**.

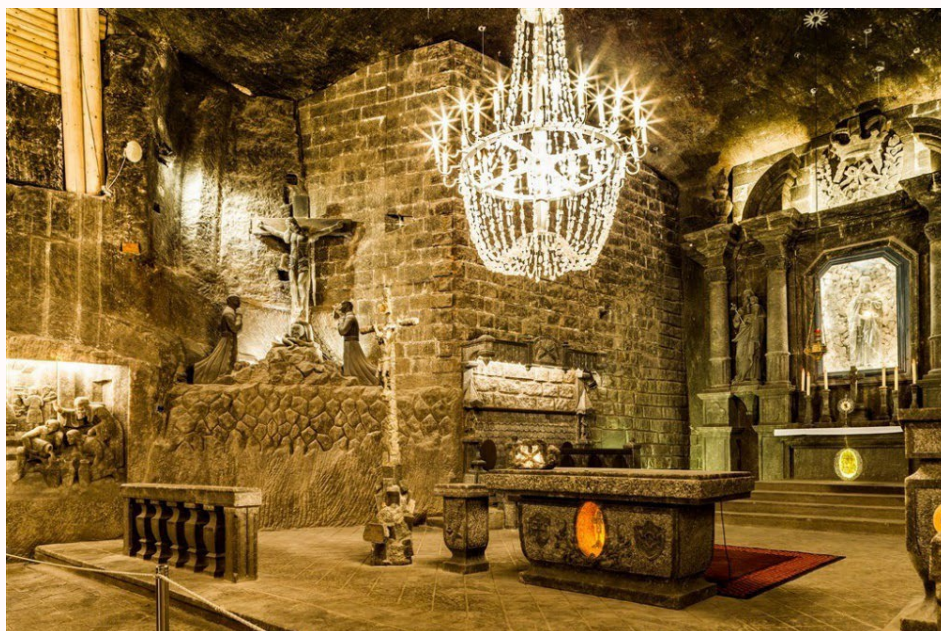
